

Visitation Guidelines: Women's Services

Hospital Visitation Hours 9 a.m. - 9 p.m.

- Quiet time for all patients is from 2 - 4 p.m. One support person is permitted during this time.
- All visitors must be in good health to visit. Visitors with fever, diarrhea, respiratory infection or cold sores will not be allowed.
- Children under the age of 12 will not be allowed to visit unless they are the child of the patient.
- Children may not sleep overnight in the patient room.
- Only one overnight guest may stay in the patient room.
- Children must be supervised at all times by an adult.
- Any visitor who appears to be under the influence of drugs or alcohol will not be allowed into the unit and will be asked to leave.
- No loitering, waiting or standing in the hallways. Visitors must wait in the waiting room.

Visitation Guidelines: Labor and Delivery

Hospital Visitation Hours 9 a.m. - 9 p.m.

- Only two support people are allowed at the bedside at one time.
- All visitors must be in good health to visit. Visitors with fever, diarrhea, respiratory infection or cold sores will not be allowed.
- Children under the age of 12 will not be allowed to visit unless they are the child of the patient.
- Children may not sleep overnight in the patient room.
- Children must be supervised at all times by an adult.
- Only one overnight guest may stay in the patient room.
- Any visitor who appears to be under the influence of drugs or alcohol will not be allowed into the unit and will be asked to leave.
- No loitering, waiting or standing in the hallways. Visitors must wait in the waiting room.
