Top 10 Reasons to Choose Roper Rehabilitation Hospital

- Roper Rehabilitation Hospital (RRH) is a hospital within a hospital. Other facilities located outside of a hospital must transport patients in emergencies. At RRH patients have immediate access to critical care doctors and intensive care units.
- 2. We get patients home! 83% of our patients were discharged home compared to 81% nationally.
- 3. Staff on the unit are dedicated to the highest quality. Over 80% of our eligible registered nurses have obtained their certification as rehab nurses and we have therapists certified in brain injury and neurodevelopmental techniques.
- 4. Roper Rehabilitation Hospital has a full kitchen and a "Real Life Room" with a car to practice your day to day skills.
- The Rapid Response and Stroke Teams are readily available in an emergency.
- 6. Dialysis is available at Roper Hospital and is scheduled to coordinate with therapy schedules.
- 7. Recreational Therapy is available for patients to assist with community re-entry.
- Since 2007, Roper Rehabilitation Hospital was in the top 10% nationally six out of seven years and was the Top Performer two of those years for overall quality of patient care.
- Dr. James Warmoth, Medical Director for the unit, has over thirty years of inpatient rehabilitation experience. Dr. Jeffrey Tubbs, who oversees our spinal cord injury program, is fellowship trained in spinal cord injury.
