In lieu of gathering in person for the **Annual Roper Xavier Society Celebration** this past weekend, we have put together this brief update to share what we had planned to highlight during the evening — a reflection on the impact made possible by your generosity and a look at the momentum building across Roper St. Francis Healthcare.


In 2025, the Roper St. Francis Foundation received more than **\$33 million in philanthropy and nonprofit grants** and secured an additional **\$16 million in government grants**, helping advance **\$86 million toward the \$100 million goal of *Imagine: The Campaign for Roper St. Francis Healthcare***. Together, this support is expanding access to care, strengthening programs, investing in caregivers, and advancing the facilities and services our growing region needs.

While we were disappointed not to gather as planned, we remain grateful for your understanding. In the spirit of stewardship and care, the food and floral arrangements prepared for the celebration were redirected to support caregivers remaining onsite to care for patients during the winter weather event, as well as local shelters and warming centers across the Lowcountry. Timothy J. Jones, MD**



OUTSTANDING PHILANTHROPIST AWARD



The recipients of the 2025 Roper St. Francis Foundation Outstanding Philanthropist Award are Stacie and Davis Marksbury.

The Outstanding Philanthropist Award recognizes individuals whose generosity creates meaningful, lasting impact and helps bring bold visions for healthcare to life.

Through their transformational \$2.5 million gift, the Marksbury family has named the new Level III Neonatal Intensive Care Unit at Roper St. Francis Healthcare. Their generosity is helping make possible the expansion of our existing Level II nursery to a Level III NICU – a project that is now moving into its next phase as construction begins.

Today, the Level II nursery cares for babies born at 32 weeks or later. As the community continues to grow and more pregnancies become high-risk, the need for advanced neonatal care has increased. The new Level III NICU will allow caregivers to provide specialized treatment for critically ill and premature infants born as early as 28 weeks, while expanding capacity, equipment, and lifesaving interventions.

Perhaps most importantly, this expansion will allow mothers and babies to remain together during their first precious days of life, rather than being separated and transferred to another facility for higher-level care. This is an extraordinary gift to families during some of the most emotional and vulnerable moments they will ever experience.

Davis and Stacie's support is already shaping the future of women's and children's care at Roper St. Francis Healthcare and will touch thousands of families for generations to come.

Beyond this transformational gift, the Marksbury family's commitment reflects a deep belief in philanthropy as a force for lasting good. Stacie also serves on the Imagine Campaign Committee, offering her time, insight, and leadership as the campaign continues to move forward.

Their generosity, leadership, and belief in Roper St. Francis Healthcare are felt far beyond this moment and exemplify the spirit of the Outstanding Philanthropist Award.
