Roper St. Francis Healthcare's three-year expansion project addresses clinical needs of the future, introducing new services, reducing wait times and reaching more patients than ever.

- **More than 300,000 square feet** of new or renovated space
- **New four-story bed tower** with 100 inpatient beds, including intensive care, intermediate care and medical-surgical units
- **Expanded Gregory M. Parker Emergency Department** with 35 patient care bays
- **Imaging services** with two CT scanners, two MRI units, Interventional Radiology
- **Women's imaging**, including new DEXA bone density scan
- **New Labor & Delivery Unit** with 6 delivery rooms, 6 nursery beds, 12 postpartum rooms
- **Perinatal Center for pregnant women** with complicating conditions
- **New Heart & Vascular Center**
- **New wound care services**
- **Surgical services** with 8 operating rooms
- **Expanded imaging, laboratory, pharmacy, dining**
- **Grand concourse** offering weather-protected link between hospital, MOB
